



Be Inclusive

- Ask for pronouns during introductions and on intake forms
- Use the name they prefer, even if it isn't on the roster
- Use & Correct Pronouns ("*she* — *sorry, THEY*" is all that's necessary)
- Actively avoid using gendered language and examples
- Include all gender or single stall bathrooms when directing people to the facilities
- Do not call out trans students for being trans. Deconstruct your concept of gender outside of class.
